



Gmail Settings

Since May 2016, Google has begun withdrawing support for certain computer protocols on the servers that provide the Gmail email service.

This means that some devices, both cameras and writers, may not be able to send emails from Gmail accounts, since this change occurs on SMTP servers in Gmail.

The manufacturer of the devices is aware of this situation and is working on the necessary updates so that access to the Gmail SMTP servers will occur through the protocols supported from that date.
